

# Choudrant High School Uniform Policy 2017-2018

## Shirt

- CHS T-Shirts - Official School-Sold Uniform T-Shirt
- Colors: royal blue, white, & black (Solid color only)
- Style: Polo style; long or short sleeve with collar; (No ties, zippers, snaps, etc.)
- Sweatshirts without hoods (solid color: royal blue, white, black)
- No logos, except Choudrant High logos
- T-shirt and Polo shirt must be neatly tucked into pants at all times. \*Shirts must be long enough to remain tucked into pants when arms are raised, and no midribs should be visible at any time. Allow for shrinkage.
- White undershirts (without writing) may be worn under polos or sweatshirts. \*\*No gray, black, or blue.
- T-shirt, Polo shirts, or sweatshirts must be worn under pullover jackets.

## Pants/Shorts/Capris/Skirts/Skortts

- Colors: Khaki/tan only (pleated or flat front)
- Fabric: Cotton or cotton polyester twill (no knit, denim, corduroy, etc.)
- Capri: Mid-calf for girls only
- Uniform length: Skirts and skortts must touch the knee cap when standing. Shorts can be no more than 3 inches from the knee cap. When purchasing allow for shrinkage and student growth during the year.
- Must be hemmed at bottom with no holes, cuts, or rips; no worn or frayed edges or spots.
- Must be of appropriate size and length and worn properly around mid-section. (No sagging)
- Belt must be worn if clothing is designed to be worn with belt. (Belt loops may not be cut off clothing.)
- No pants, sweatpants, wind pants, etc. may be worn under skirts.
- Brown or black leggings or neutral hose may be worn under skirts.
- Pants, shorts, or skirts should not be form fitting. Skinny style pants are prohibited. No elastic in the cuffs of pants.
- The following are not allowed as part of a uniform: chains, bandanas, scarves, athletic type headbands or bracelets, drawstring pants, cargo pants or cargo shorts, carpenter pants, hip hugger pants, zip away pants, clothing with drawings or writings.

## Belts

- Must be worn at the waist in belt loops, visible, and buckled at all times.
- Colors: solid colors – brown, black, khaki, or white
- Belts and buckles should be plain.
- Belt rules apply to boys and girls.

## Shoes

- Sensible shoes with low or no heels
- Boots may be worn with pants and skirts only; pants may not be tucked in boots. Boots must be plain and black or brown in color.
- Shoes must be laced or securely fastened at all times; sandals are allowed as long as they are not all rubber.
- The following are not allowed as part of uniform shoes: socks with sandals, camo or rubber boots or shoes, house slippers, rubber flip-flops, beach shoes, fuzzy boots, crocs, etc.

**Socks**—Socks may be solid white or black; crew length or ankle length are permitted. No socks higher than mid-calf allowed.

## Sweatshirts and Long Sleeve Sweaters

- Colors: Solid royal blue, black, or gray.
- Sweatshirts may be worn over uniform shirt or turtle neck.
- No logo or emblems over 1 inch is allowed except Choudrant High logos
- No oversized sweatshirts or sweaters; no vests allowed.
- Sweaters should be long sleeved and may be worn buttoned or unbuttoned over uniform shirt.
- No hoodies at all!

## Coats, Jackets, Cold Weather Gear

- No hoods permitted on jackets.
- Must fit properly, not oversized
- If student wears any type jacket that will remain on all day, it must be SOLID black, gray, or royal blue. (Example: fleece, windbreaker, button-up sweater, etc.) No stripes, checks, designs, etc.
- CHS school letter jackets and club jackets are allowed.
- No company logos or emblems over 1 inch in size are allowed on jackets or coats.
- Trench coats are not allowed.
- Starter jackets with logos (Dallas Cowboys, Saints, Cadillac, etc) are not allowed.
- Teachers may ask students to remove jackets while in classroom.
- Winter scarves may be worn with coats but removed before tardy bell each morning. They should be placed in locker or book bag.

## Gloves, Hats

- No gloves (cold gear or decorative) are to be worn inside building.
- No hats or caps of any style permitted.

**Hair**—All hair (girls & boys) should be cut to remain out of eyes at all times and should be of natural color. No bold colors allowed in hair. No mohawks allowed. No hair inserts (beads, feathers, etc.) allowed at school.

**Tattoos**—No visible tattoos at school or at school-sponsored events.

## Spirit Day or Reward Day Attire

- Blue jeans may be worn with school, athletic, or club shirts. Jeans may not have writings, holes, cuts, tape, bleached, frayed edges, or worn spots. No colored jeans!
- No jogging pants, fleece pants, or denim shorts.
- CHS athletic team wind pants may be worn with matching jackets.
- Designated club attire may be worn with prior approval of administration.

## Rules to Follow

1. Piercings: Girls may have piercings in ears only. No tongue, lip, brow, or nose piercings; spacers nor bandaids are allowed to cover holes in tongue, lip, brow, or nose.
2. Belt buckles should be plain, normal sized, and contain no writing or symbols.
3. Hoodies: Not allowed on campus
4. Recommended during winter season: Sweatshirts over turtle necks or polos; fleece
5. Skirts and shorts should touch knee cap.
6. Remember leggings must have toe built in...cannot start at ankle.
7. Under shirts must be WHITE with no visible writings.
8. Students should not write on clothing or skin.
9. Girls' hair bands should be worn across top of head and not across forehead.
10. No scarves should be worn with uniforms. No sun shades should be visible while at school. Cargo shorts and cargo pants are not allowed.
11. Remember students represent CHS at all functions and should dress and act accordingly.
